

RECOMMENDATION FOR THE CARE AND MAINTENANCE OF THE PRODUCT

With your purchase you have come into possession of a faucet of Neve Rubinetterie s.r.l.

Following the simple instructions below you can keep the aesthetic appearance and functionality unchanged over time.

FINISHES:

CHROME, COLOR, PVD

When cleaning, it is very important to use the cleaner most suitable for the surface area of the article, measuring quantity and time of application, following the instructions provided by the detergent manufacturer. In no case should liquid detergents containing substances that are abrasive or based on hydrochloric/muriatic acid, formic, phosphoric, acetic or ydrofluoric acid, ammonia, bleach, household acids and other disinfectants be used. Such products can cause significant damage even if used only once and therefore should not be used on sanitary equipment near the taps, especially if using a spray product.

Only use a suitable liquid detergent or water and soap for the daily cleaning of the article, applied on a cloth and never directly on the surfaces. Rub with sponges or soft cloths. It is essential to proceed with a drying at every use to be carried out with soft cloth or "deer skin", in order to prevent the formation of limestone deposits.

STAINLESS

It is recommended to gently scrub in the same direction as brushing and not to use abrasive products or metal sponges, rinsing and drying the surface with a soft cloth or "deer skin" to avoid limestone deposits. Do not use products containing soda or solvents, abrasive powders, bleach, hydrochloric acid, acetic acid, hydrofluoric acid, chlorine cleaners or silver-specific.

AERATOR

It is recommended that the aerator is cleaned periodically to remove any deposits by following the steps below:

- Unscrew the aerator by turning counterclockwise
- Remove any deposits on the aerator filter
- Reassemble aerator by checking the correct gasket position
- Use appropriate disassembly equipment
- For cleaning do not use aggressive products

WARNINGS

It is recommended that the water supply pipes are thoroughly cleaned before installation of the taps and prior to putting them into service.

Make sure filters or stop valves are installed to avoid miscellaneous deposits and dirt in the screw disks or cartridges.
